Dear Mr. Hoover:

I have received your letter of 30 September and regret very much the decision communicated therein to terminate our agreement relative to personnel investigations on 15 October 1947.

I realize the extra load that has been recently thrust upon you, and how you must be burdened. However, the nature of our operations makes a security investigation for our people imperative. Consequently, I should appreciate very much if you might be able to reconsider your decision, or, at least, postpone its going into effect until the National Security Council can consider a memorandum I am sending them, in order to resolve the problem. I am inclosing a copy of the memorandum for your information.
