MEMORANDUM FOR: The Record**SUBJECT: AEDINOSAUR--Current Developments**

1. On 7 August 1958 I met with [redacted] in New York. [redacted] had asked him for further payments on account, but [redacted] will make no more payments until authorized by us. He will be away from his office on vacation from 8 August until 25 August.

2. [redacted] told [redacted] he had made no arrangements with [redacted] for publication of the book in question. He also expressed surprise that we had been billed for three sets of reproduction proofs and said he did not know the third set had been made. He said he had not provided any reproduction proofs to [redacted]

3. In accordance with our telephone conversation of today, [redacted] will arrange through the Contacts Office to get the full story from [redacted] on their dealings with [redacted]. After talking to [redacted] called the [redacted] who said they had the third set of proofs in their vault, in accordance with standard practice. They said this set had not been out of their possession.

4. [redacted] has asked [redacted] if they can destroy the type because of the difficulty of storage. [redacted] requests that the type not be destroyed until the book appears in Europe, which will be in two or three weeks. We will have [redacted] office direct [redacted] to hold the type for several weeks.
